SCREENING INFORMATION

Early Childhood/Kindergarten screening will take place from February through May, 2009 at the district's PAT building. In order to be screened, early childhood students must be three years of age before August 1. Kindergarten students must be five years of age before August 1. BOARD OF EDUCATION

The governing body for the Neosho R-5 School District is a seven-member board of education. Two members are elected each year at the municipal election held the first Tuesday in April. The deadline for filing as a candidate for the board of education is 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, nine weeks preceding the election date. Regular meetings of the board of education are held the third Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at the Middle School. Board meetings are open to the public.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

School policy provides that to be eligible for transportation services, a student must reside at least one mile from his/her school of attendance.
